
## Adding JBLearning Content to Your Moodle LMS

This document provides steps for adding, or deep-linking, JBLearning online courseware within your Moodle Learning Management System (LMS). Note, an LTI integration with JBLearning is a prerequisite, and these instructions assume applicable initial steps are complete.

 First, navigate to a course, or create a new course, in which you would like to add JBLearning Course contents in your Moodle LMS. Then, toggle the **Edit mode** button at the top-right corner of the page to **ON**.











 Next, scroll down as needed to locate the chapter/module you would like to add JBLearning course contents, and click on Add an activity or resource button at the bottom of the chapter/module you choose.



3. From the options in the pop-up window, select the preconfigured **JBLearning Courses** tool.










4. On the following page, under the **General** settings, click on the **Select content** button to proceed.



5. A popup window displays a list of available courses to which your system has access. Use the **Search by Course Name** field to locate your course as needed. The list displayed automatically returns results as keywords are entered. Click on your course's name to display its contents. Note, it is important to only add content from approved titles for your course. Students are unable to access any content outside of your chosen curriculum.











6. Contents are organized using the default course structure, typically by chapters aligned with the textbook. You may add the chapter contents to the according modules/chapters one at a time (**recommended**) by selecting the checkbox to the left of the chapter name, then clicking **Continue**.



The following confirmation page displays a preview of the contents selected. Scroll to the bottom and click **Import Resources**.













8. The following summary page displays a preview of the contents selected. When you are ready, click on **Save and return to course** button at the bottom.



9. You are returned to your course where the imported contents are added to the chapter/module. Repeat these steps as needed to continue building your course.











10. Alternatively, you may select individual items from chapter(s) from the menu one at a time, or multiple in combination. Using the same JBLearning Courses tool as shown in Steps 2-4, expand the course's content menu and use the respective checkboxes to the left of the item to import, then click **Continue**.



11. The confirmation page displays a preview of the content selected. When satisfied, click the **Import Resources** button.











12. The following summary page displays a preview of the contents selected. When you are ready, click on **Save and return to course** button at the bottom.



13. You are returned to your course where the imported contents are added to the chapter/module. Repeat these steps as needed to continue building your course.










14. Lastly, you may also add all contents to your D2L course in one step by selecting the checkbox to the left of the course name, then clicking **Continue**. **Note**: This method is not usually recommended as this results in putting all items in one chapter/module, and you may need to reorganize your course afterwards.











15. The confirmation page displays a preview of the content selected. When satisfied, click the **Import Resources** button.



16. The following summary page displays a preview of the contents selected. When you are ready, click on **Save and return to course** button at the bottom.









17. You are returned to your course home page in which all items from every chapter are added to one module/chapter.
